6. ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN OR PRESIDING PERSON

1. Review of Corporate Business Plan - 7 March 2018

The SMRC conducted a strategic workshop to review our Corporate Business Plan. The workshop was facilitated by Martin Drydale, AEC Group, and attended by Regional Councillors, Regional Executive Officers from our member councils and SMRC Executive staff. A revised Plan will be circulated to members for feedback prior to Council adoption in June 2018.

2. Local Government Waste - 8 March 2018

In conjunction with WALGA and MWAC the SMRC hosted a local government waste industry information session relating to the China National Sword Policy and potential impacts on MRF operators and local government waste contracts. The CEO presentation included suitable financial gate fee models and China's import restrictions on recyclable contaminated material.

3. FOGO and Recycling update to RRRC Project Participants

The SMRC invited and hosted at the RRRC, three separate meetings, for elected members and select officers of each of the RRRC project member councils for approximately two hours to provide an insight of the current operation and strategic horizon of the RRRC Project.

The following meetings were conducted:

- 1. City of Fremantle 13 March 2018
- 2. City of Melville 26 March 2018
- 3. Town of East Fremantle 28 March 2018

4. Joint briefing session for SMRC Member Local Governments at the City of Melville on Thursday 5 April 2018

The briefing session organised by SMRC, provided our member councils with a progress report on the adopted Regional Strategic Waste Management Plan 2016, Food Organics Green Organics (FOGO) City of Melville trial and the current status and impacts with China's recycling policy. The session was well attended by members and provided informative progress on the SMRC's RRRC Project short to medium term strategic horizon.

5. EPA - Waste to Energy Plants review of residual waste definition - 6 April 2018.

The SMRC has received correspondence from the Chair of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), that at the request of the Minster for Environment, the Hon. Stephen Dawson MLC, the EPA intends to undertake a review of approved waste to energy proposals relating to feedstocks and residual waste definitions.

The EPA requests that this information be conveyed to our member councils as it may have bearing to waste management strategies.

This announcement is encouraging and sends a signal to local government. For those of you at the Waste presentation "What Counts as Residual" is an important issue in FOGO implementation. In NSW, Energy from Waste solutions are acceptable after all reasonable steps have been taken to recover waste through avoidance, recycling and composting. The review may follow a similar path and find that a 3 bin FOGO collection system is fully compliant with the waste hierarchy and that residual waste from a 3 bin FOGO system is eligible feedstock for WtE. A more rigorous classification of what can and cannot go to EfW may cause some Councils who have signed EfW contracts to look more closely at the ramifications of such a review.

6. Correspondence from the Minister of Environment – 12 April 2018

The Hon Stephen Dawson, Minister for Environment, wrote to praise the SMRC and WALGA for convening an information session for local government on China import restrictions on recyclable contaminated material. The Minister also convened a meeting with key stakeholders (including myself as MWAC Chair and Tim Youe as SMRC CEO). These discussions resulted in the Minister deciding to establish a Waste Taskforce consisting of waste industry, government and community examine how to support and develop a sustainable and productive recycling sector in WA. He also advised that all environment ministers will discuss this at a national level.

7. State Government Waste Taskforce first meeting planned for 23 April 2018

The Minister for Environment has today advised MWAC and SMRC that the first meeting of the taskforce, chaired by his Parliamentary Secretary Mr Reece Whitby MLA, will take place next Monday. Myself as Chair of MWAC and Mr Tim Youé, as CEO of SMRC have been appointed to the 18-person membership which includes all the leading industry players. The Taskforce will prepare the Minister for Environment, advice on recycling market issues and opportunities in Western Australia. Reference groups may be formed to consider specific issues as needed.

8. Appointments of SMRC CEO Tim Youé

Mr Youe has been elected as Chair of the Officers Advisory Group to MWAC on 9 April for a term of two years. He has also been appointed as a Director of the Waste Management Association of Australia (WMAA) for a term of two years commencing 11 May 2018.

9. Media

The SMRC CEO was recently interviewed for two ABC TV News programmes regarding the "China Crisis" one for ABC WA News on 16 Feb and one for ABC National News on 15 April. Media continues to show a keen interest in the waste and recycling sector.

However, as neither the Establishment Agreement nor the Project Participants Agreement provides for, or contemplates, the review by a withdrawing participant of the outcome of the notional winding up or terms of an amended business plan, the SMRC and the Ongoing Project Participants' are not obliged to consider the City's alternative proposal.

The SMRC has acted in good faith in complying with its obligation to procure the preparation of the amended business plan and the notional winding up. It has done so in a manner consistent with the process when the City of Canning withdrew from the Project."
