Containers for Change

Whether you're keen to earn a bit of extra cash, raise money for your local sports club or event, or donate to your favourite charity, you can start earning 10 cents for every eligible drink container collected. For more information and locations to return to visit: containersforchange.com.au/wa

Remember to rinse and take the lids off!

Acceptable beverage containers include most aluminium, glass, plastic, steel and liquid paper board between 150ml and 3 litres. You can recycle lids from these containers too – remember to remove them first





Bin Collection Information



Place bins away from other objects with the front facing the street.



1m from trees 0.5m between bins 1m from cars







Ensure bins are placed out by 6am on collection day



Bins must weigh less than 70kg to be collected



Do not overfill your bins and ensure lids are firmly closed so items do not spill out

How do I book Verge Valet?


How far in advance do I need to book?

Bookings need to be made by the Thursday before your collection date. Collections are scheduled for Mondays in Peppermint Grove. Simply book online and select from the displayed dates.

What can I put out for a Verge Valet collection?







You can change any of your bulk waste collections into a green waste collection if you prefer

Verge Valet is intended for items that can no longer be used. Donate items that are too good to be thrown away.



What won't be accepted?

Asbestos, batteries, building materials, household hazardous waste, glass panels, pesticides, paint and vehicle parts. Drop these items off at the West Metro Recycling Centre 7 days a week – some are free and some for a fee. See the West Metro Recycling Centre section of this guide for details.

Help - I need to change my booking!

You can change, cancel, or postpone your booking up to **one business day** before your collection date. Click the CHANGE A BOOKING tab on **www.vergevalet.com.au** or phone the Verge Valet Collection Team on 6336 7223. **Please give at least one business day's notice** or you will lose your collection allocation.

What happens to the waste collected by Verge Valet?

Neat piles of separated waste help us recycle as much as we can. We reprocess all the greenwaste and recover as much recyclable material from bulk waste as possible. Mattresses, e-waste and white goods are recycled by specialists and fridges etc are safely de-gassed.



Item beyond repair? Too much greenwaste?

Verge Valet[™] replaces the traditional bulk verge and green waste collection, giving you year-round access to verge waste collections at a time convenient to you.



Household hazardous waste (HHW) includes unwanted household products that contain harmful chemicals, are flammable, corrosive or explosive. Limits of up to 20kg or 20L per material type will be accepted free of charge, per person, per visit.
